Dear Residents

The new Village Hall has had great reviews from those who have used it. At the present time, the upstairs room is used for Parish Council meetings on the second Wednesday of the month, by Coppull Women's Institute on the second Thursday of the month and a photographic class on the first Monday of the month. There has also been a children's party and a few other activities are in the pipeline. It will also be used each year on polling day! If you wish to hire the hall for a child's party or a group, please contact the Clerk in the first instance.

The downstairs will be used by Sunny Brow Playschool starting from October this year. If anyone is interested in putting their child's name down, please see the photos within this newsletter and details of who to contact.

New office hours - the Parish Council office at the Leisure Centre is now only open for visitors in the mornings, 9am to 12.30pm, this is to allow the Clerk to be able to get on with her work without interruptions and it also applies to Parish Councillors, myself included!

The Leisure Park has recently had new CCTV installed, which gives great coverage of the park and car parks. Hopefully, this will stop the vandalism to the play areas and dog signs, and remind people to pick up their dog's poo! There are a small group of youths who are causing quite a lot of concern with anti-social behaviour. Do you know what your kids are doing in the evenings? They are on CCTV and the Police have been informed.

Dog fouling is a real concern within the village as a whole, but reports have been received for German Lane, Chapel Lane, the Springfield Leisure Park, Tansley playing field and on walks up to schools! This is not acceptable. Most dog owners are responsible and pick up after their dogs, but there are some who don't. If you see anyone not picking up after their dog, please let us know, get a photo of the culprit if you can, and let's try and end this bad practice in our village.

PLAY AREA CONSULTATIONS

The Parish Council is looking into upgrading the three plays owned by the Parish Council and would like your input. Some of the equipment needs to be taken off as it is near the end of its lifespan. What sort of play equipment would you like to see to replace it?

Springfield Park - the small swing and the mum/baby swing has had to be removed as the wood posts were rotting. This was very popular, so maybe another of these would be preferred?

Byron Crescent - none needs removing immediately, but the climbing unit will need repairing or removing in the near future.

Tansley Avenue - most of this play area is ok, a see saw has already been removed and needs to be replaced, but with what?

All play areas will need to have complete safety surfacing put down.

These costs will come out of the Community Infrastructure Levy, a percentage of which is received from Chorley Council.

There is also a suggestion of putting a football pitch on the **Tansley play area** for the community, so that this can be used all year round. What are your views on this?
Further funding would most likely have to be obtained to go towards this.
