Thanks to everyone involved with installing the Christmas lighting: Chris Kay, Bill Bailey, Carl Brown, Paul Taylor for the ladder, George Evans for transportation. Next year, we have had an offer from a resident to organise a proper switch on and carol singing event. Hopefully, the lights will start to be put up in October, with a view to holding the event nearer to Christmas. Further details will be put in a future newsletter. I would also like to thank all our volunteers who help each year with the gardens and in particular Olga, who has transformed German Lane!

The Queen's Jubilee is taking place from 2 June this year and the Parish Council would like to organise an event on that day, but need volunteers to help. If you have any ideas for the event or would like to help, please contact the Clerk. The event would take place on the Springfield Leisure Park.

Dog fouling is again a problem with the darker mornings and nights. Problem areas reported are German Lane, Park Road opposite the school, Bentham Street, Chapel Lane, Lancaster Street. If you have a dog then you must clean up properly after it. Children don't always see it and step in it, then take it into their homes or classrooms. CCTV cameras are being monitored more closely now

and anyone seen not picking up will be fined, named and shamed. Residents can report anyone seen not picking up in the strictest confidence.

The rules and restrictions regarding Covid-19 have now been relaxed. With this in mind, please consider joining your local groups again to enable them to keep running and benefiting residents.

The Parish Council has set the budget/precept for 2022/23 (left). Due to considerable increases in services, the precept had to be raised by £8,000, which works out at just a £2.86 increase for each household on a Band D rate. The Parish Council has kept the precept as low as possible for the previous few years, but this could not continue to keep the same level of services.

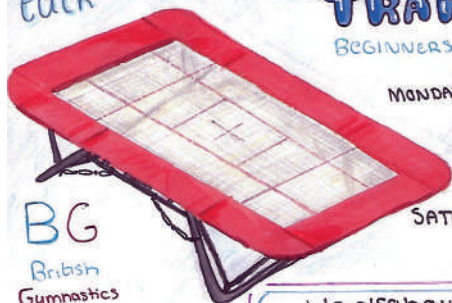
With walks from half a mile to twelve miles plus long, and a note of suitability for push-chairs and wheelchairs, everyone can find a walk to enjoy.

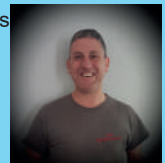
