COPPULL NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN UPDATE



Update: We can confirm that the screening version of the Neighbourhood Plan has been submitted to Chorley Council after it passed unanimously a vote by Coppull Parish Council.

The screening process via Chorley Council takes six weeks and once this

stage has been done, we may have some further reports to gather or work to do but we are hoping that this will be minimal.

By the time you read this update we will have had several pop-up shops in the village pubs and possibly the library to let residents have a look at the policies that form the Plan, which have been adopted from the initial survey back in 2021.

You are all hopefully aware that whilst we cannot, through the Neighbourhood Plan, stop any further housing development in the village, the Plan once adopted will be a legal document and will have to be used as a measure against any future development proposals taking all the policies into account.

The aim of the Steering Group is to have the Neighbourhood Plan completed and adopted by March 2025.

As a Steering Group we want to thank Coppull Parish Council for their support and advice throughout.

What we do

The county council is responsible for over 4,300 miles of roads of which approximately 1,800 miles are part of Lancashire's 'Priority Road Network' for salting and snow clearing.



- It can take our gritters up to four hours to grit one route and even longer in severe weather conditions. This means sometimes we can't grit as often as we would like.
- When low temperatures are forecast, we grit the roads as a precaution before the frost forms, usually during the evening or early hours of the morning. Remember weather forecasts are only a guide and our local knowledge and expertise is vital in deciding what to do.
- Despite our best efforts, winter weather can still make roads treacherous and there is no guarantee that roads will always be completely free of ice and snow. Take extra care.
